Junior School Uniform Guidance

Purchasing Uniform

You will find below the uniform lists for children in both KS1 (Reception to Year 2) and KS2 (Years 3 to 6). All items marked **Grange** must be bought from our supplier Schoolblazer via their website: www.schoolblazer.com. Other items may be bought from our supplier or elsewhere. The terminology used for the items is designed to be consistent with the Schoolblazer website to enable you to easily select appropriate items of clothing.

High standards of appearance are part of the culture of the school and so the guidance below is to help you make sure that the children are dressed appropriately during each of the terms.

Winter and Summer Uniform

As well as for individual comfort, practicality and smartness of appearance, the uniform is designed to provide clothing options that are suitable for the seasonal changes we experience in the UK i.e., we have a winter and a summer uniform. The table below indicates when summer or winter uniform should be worn throughout the school year, recognising that sometimes the climate is not always as we would prefer in the summer months! Please refer to the uniform lists for items included as winter or summer uniform – crucially, we ask that the children wear the combinations as indicated.

Hair and Jewellery

Hair must – whilst in school uniform – be clean, sensible, neat, kept away from the eyes and of a natural colour, in line with the high standards that the school sets for uniform and appearance Children should have long hair tied back in school using plain green, black or brown hair accessories.

Children are not allowed to wear any jewellery except a watch or medi-alert items, nor may they wear make-up or nail polish. If children have their ears pierced, we ask that this done at the beginning of the summer holidays so as not to restrict them from taking part in Games, PE and Swimming should they have it done at another time.

Winter Uniform

Grange unisex blazer (green)

Grange school tie (velcro)

White shirt (long or short sleeved)

Long grey socks (short socks are acceptable if wearing trousers) or dark grey woollen tights

Plain black shoes (no boots or heels)

Plain green, brown or black hair accessories

Navy art overall

Plain black waterproof cagoule (please make this available in school each day)

Grange green or black beanie hat (optional)

Plain green, grey or black gloves (optional)

Wellington boots (own - when needed)

Summer Uniform - as above with combination of:

Grange summer dress (in lieu of pinafore)

White ankle socks (in lieu of grey socks/tights)

Green, grey or black sun hat (optional)

Sportswear (all year round)

Grange grey crested sweatshirt

Grange grey jogging bottoms

Grange white crested polo

Grange green PE shorts or **Grange** white PE shorts

Grange boot bag

White sports socks

White trainers – not boot style and non-marking soles (no flashing lights or wheelies!)

Winter Uniform

Grange unisex blazer (green)

Grey shorts or trousers or Grange grey kilt

Grange school tie

Grange v-neck jumper (optional)

Grange school scarf (optional)

Grange reversible stormproof jacket (optional)

Grange Junior backpack

White Shirt (long or short sleeved)

Long grey socks (short socks are acceptable if wearing trousers) or dark grey woollen tights

Plain black shoes (no boots or heels)

Plain green, brown or black hair accessories

Navy art overall

Plain black waterproof cagoule (please make this available in school each day)

Grange green or black beanie hat (optional)

Plain green, grey or black gloves (optional)

Wellington boots (own – when needed)

Summer Uniform - as above with combination of:

Grange summer dress (in lieu of kilt)

White ankle socks (in lieu of grey socks/tights)

Green, grey or black sun hat (optional)

Sportswear (all year round)

Grange tracksuit top

Grange tracksuit trousers (used for outdoor education, but optional for PE/Games)

Grange games bag

Grange boot bag

Grange black baselayer top or plain black base layer (optional)

Black swimming costume, shorts or trunks

PE Lessons:

Grange white crested polo

Grange black skort or **Grange** white PE shorts

White sports socks

White trainers – not boot style and non-marking soles

Games Lessons:

Grange black shorts/skorts (for Hockey, Rugby & Football)

Grange white crested polo (for Netball) or Grange black t-shirt (for Football & Rugby)

Black games socks (for Hockey, Football & Rugby)

Shin pads - essential (for Hockey & Football)

Gumshield - essential (for Hockey & Rugby)

Hockey stick (for Hockey - optional)

Football boots (for Football & Rugby) and Trainers (for indoor Games lessons/Netball)
